Maja Relja MD, PhD is Professor of Neurology at the Medical School University of Zagreb (Croatia) and Head of the Referral Center for Movement Disorders and Neurodegeneration Department of Neurology, University Hospital Center Zagreb, University of Zagreb, School of Medicine

Born in Split, Croatia, she graduated in medicine from Medical Faculty of Zagreb and achieved a Doctorship of Sciences in 1980. She was a Research Fellow at NIMH (Washington D.C. USA) and a Visiting Professor, Department of Neurology, Turku University, Finland.

She was the first to characterize peripheral DA receptors in genitourinary system. Her main research interests are in Parkinson's disease and dystonia and in the development of novel clinical applications of Botulinum toxin. She has organized several international meetings for Movement Disorders. She is a member of American Academy of Neurology, the Movement Disorder Society and other medical organization, vice-president of Dystonia Europe and president of Croatian Association for Movement Disorders
